In the context of (online) privacy, I have drawn up a privacy statement for bracesforfun.com. I have the right to change this statement at any time. That is why I recommend that you read the statement when you visit my website. This statement contains information about the goals I pursue when recording personal data collected on the website, and how you can exercise your rights with regard to your data.

Collection of Personal Information

Bracesforfun.com obtains personal data from you, for example the data you provide to me via the website, e-mail, telephone and what's app. I process your personal data because you use the services and / or because you provide this information to me yourself, for example via a comment under a blog post, when registering for a service or when registering for the blogs.

Below you will find an overview of the personal data that are processed:

- First Name;
- possibly last name;
- e-mail address;
- your website;
- possibly your telephone number;
- company profile (think of Chamber of Commerce number, bank account, address and Company Name);
- IP address;
- device type;
- other personal data that you actively provide, for example in a response you post or in correspondence;
- data about your activities on the website (think of browser type and language, referral and exit pages, operating system and other data).

If you buy a video or product, the following data will be processed (with WooCommerce):

- First Name;
- last name;
- optionally the country where you live;
- optional street and house number
- optional zip code;
- optional place name;
- e-mail address;
- username and password for your account.

When paying by bank transfer, I will also receive your bank account number. You can request me to delete your account and thus all your data by e-mail. You also lose access to the paid environment. If you do not use your account, it will be automatically deleted after 1 year of not logging in. Pending orders, and thus your data, will be deleted after 7 days. Canceled orders will be deleted after 3 days.

Purpose, basis and retention period for processing personal data

Bracesforfun.com processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- If you send me an e-mail, I will see your e-mail address, name and the content of the e-mail. I delete all emails from a year or older once a year.
- For the statistics program Google Analytics. I use Google Analytics to analyze your behavior on the website in order to improve the website and to tailor the offer to your preferences. The tracking data via Google Analytics is stored for 14 months.
- To make invoices I process your name, e-mail address, invoice address, telephone number, customer number and Chamber of Commerce number. I need this information to process payments. For the tax authorities, these data must be kept for 7 years. Then I will delete it.

Your personal information will not be used for purposes other than the purposes for which you provided the information, unless I obtain express permission from you, or unless otherwise required or permitted by law. Your data will not be used for commercial purposes and also not for / for charities.

I do not use my website to collect special personal information such as information about political opinions, race, religious opinions, health, criminal records or other matters.

Rights

You have the right to request access to your personal data. After receiving your request, you will receive an overview of your personal data within 1 month. If any inaccuracies appear, you can request that this data be adjusted, supplemented, deleted or blocked. You can do this independently in Mailchimp, for which there is a link at the bottom of each e-mail.

You can also request me to transfer your personal data or you can object to the processing of your personal data due to special personal circumstances. To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, please enclose a copy of your ID with the request. Make in this copy your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Citizen Service Number (BSN) black. This is to protect your privacy.

Security

I think the protection of your data is very important and that is why I take appropriate measures to prevent misuse, loss, unauthorized access, unwanted disclosure and unauthorized modification. If you feel that your data is not properly secured or there are indications of abuse, please contact me at info@Bracesforfun.com

I protect your personal data in the following ways:

- Security software, such as a virus scanner and firewall.
- My computer is protected with a password.
- TLS (formerly SSL) I send your data via a secure

Internet connection. You can see this at the address bar "https" and the padlock in the address bar.

Special and / or sensitive personal data

I do not intend to collect data about website visitors under the age of 16, unless they have permission from their parents or guardian. However, I cannot check whether a visitor is older than 16 years. I therefore advise parents to be involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children from being collected without parental consent. If you think that personal data has been collected from someone under the age of 16 without permission, please contact me and I can delete the data.

Cookies

Bracesforfun.com uses functional, analytical and tracking cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored in the browser of your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit the website. Bracesforfun.com uses cookies with a purely technical functionality. These ensure that the website works properly and that, for example, your preferred settings are remembered.

Bracesforfun.com also places cookies that track your surfing behavior, for example via Google Analytics and Facebook Pixel. On your first visit to the website you are informed about the cookies and you have been asked for permission to place them. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information previously saved via your browser settings.

Social media buttons

On the Bracesforfun.com blog you will find social media buttons that make it easy for both you and me to share my blogs on social media. Most social media channels work with cookies. I have no influence on that. Read the privacy statements of the social media channels to know how they handle collected information.

To file a complaint

Do you want to file a complaint about the way I protect your personal data? This is possible here through the national supervisory authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
